Earlier in the week I was finally able to sit down and input the many responses to our Spring surveys. We received 111 parent responses in all, which is a very good response to a school survey. Thank you for your time and consideration. There were also many responses to the parent vision questionnaire, and another 220 responses from the children with their thoughts on values too, so I had quite a task to input everything.

I am working on analysing and drawing themes together this weekend and hope to bring you these next week. I can see from my first scan of the free text responses that we have some suggestions around communications and catering, which we have already begun to discuss and make plans for as a leadership team.

I am really proud and very happy, on behalf of the team at St Peter's, to bring you some of the early conclusions from the data side of the survey:

- 98% of responses would recommend St Peter's to another parent.
- 97% of responses agree that their child is happy at St Peter's.
- 97% of responses agree that their child is safe at St Peter's.
- 95% of responses agree that we support children to be well-behaved.

It is wonderful to see so many people supporting the constant efforts of all of us here to make St Peter's a place of joy, security and learning for your children. However, we are never complacent about this and will continue to strive for further improvement every day. 'Better never stops!'

I look forward to bringing you further conclusions next week.

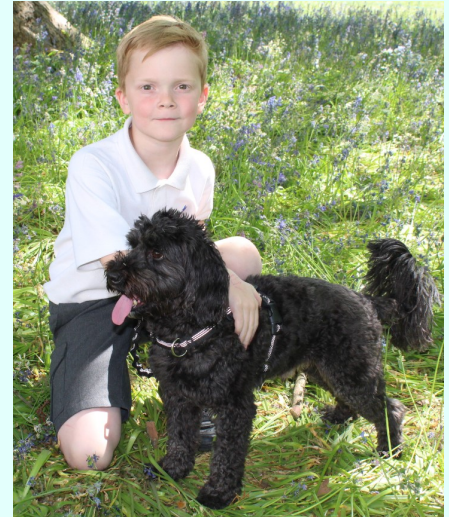
