- Practice the green cross code on your way to and from school - reminding them to stop, look, listen and think

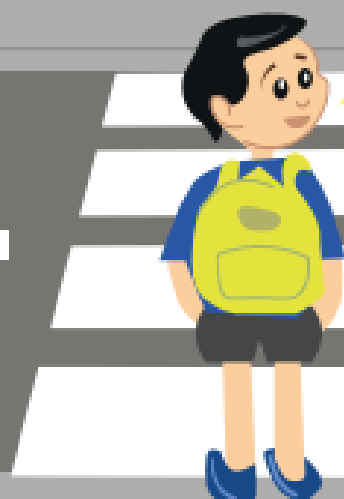
## I don't have time to walk!

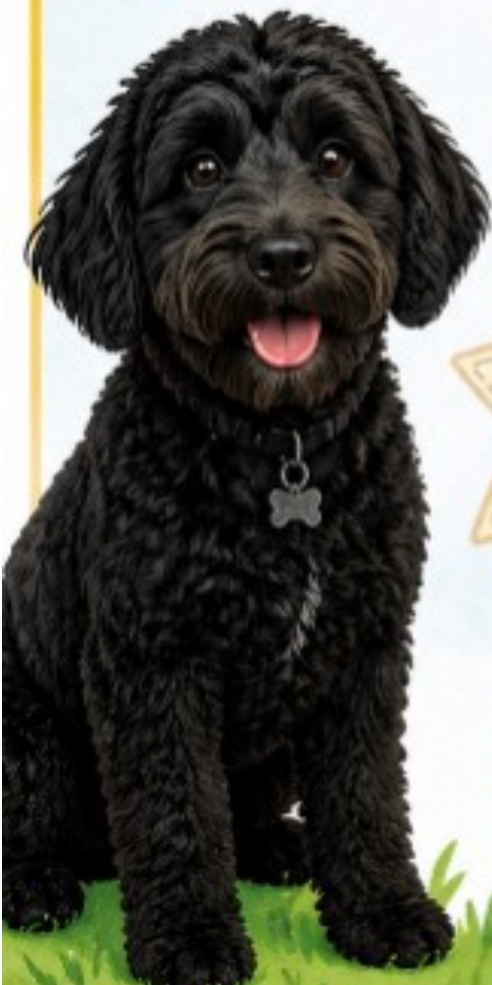
