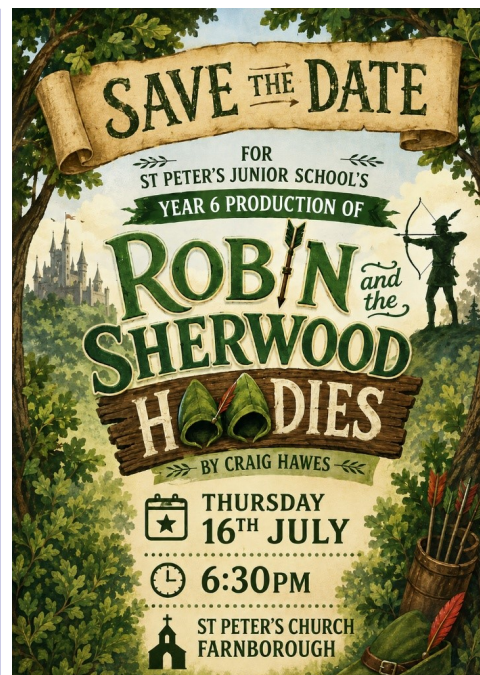
Have a brilliant half-term break with lots of family time and fun. We look forward to seeing everyone again on Tuesday 2nd June.

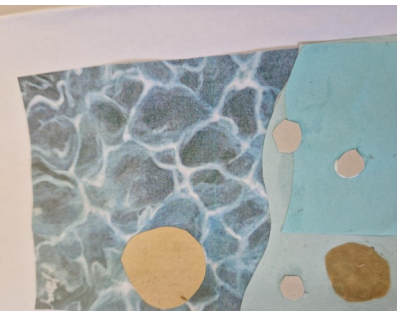

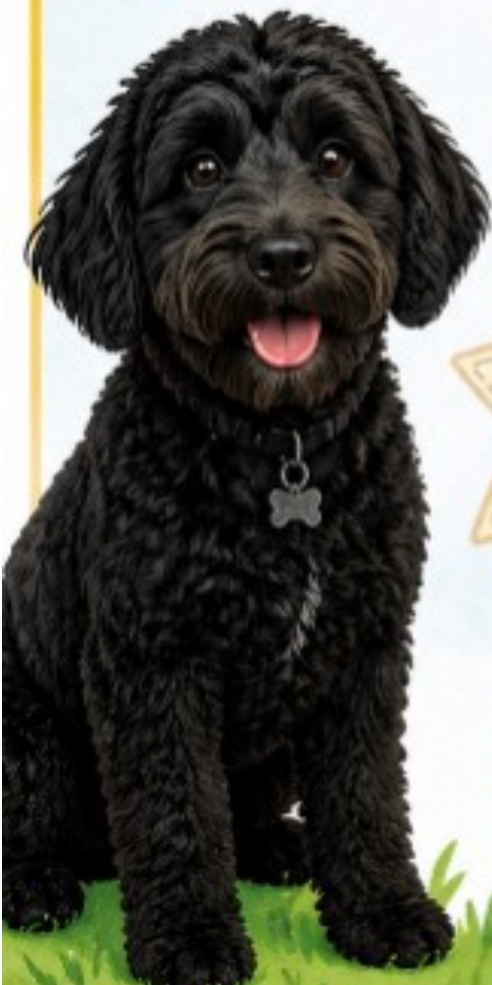
