For 10 dojo points

- Create and decorate a timeline of Ancient Egyptian civilization.
- Create a leaflet about an Ancient Egyptian exhibit for a museum.
- Draw/paint a picture of something from Ancient Egypt. Write a caption or piece of writing to go with it.

For 20 dojo points

- Research mathematics in Ancient Egypt and create an information page about it to share with others.
- Create an information page about an aspect of life in Ancient Egypt.
- Draw and label a map of Ancient Egypt showing key sites along the River Nile.

For 30 dojo points

- Create a 3D model of an artefact from Ancient Egyptian times. This could be (but is not limited to) any of the following:
 - A death mask
 - A model of a sarcophagus
 - A cartouche
- Write a time-travel story set in Ancient Egypt where the main characters have to solve a mystery/problem to get back to modern times.
